



Participatory Workshop Advances Water Governance in Jabal Moussa Biosphere Reserve

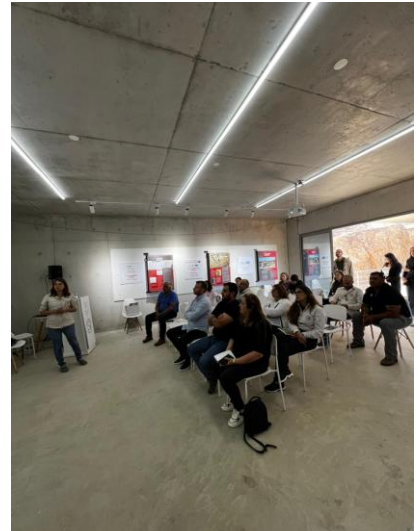
As part of the RES-MAB project, the Association for the Protection of Jabal Moussa (APJM) organized a participatory workshop using the “World Café” format on October 22, 2025, bringing together key stakeholders to strengthen water governance in the Jabal Moussa Biosphere Reserve.

The workshop gathered experts from OIKOS alongside representatives of local authorities and members of the local community. The session began with a review of the project’s main activities, followed by an in-depth discussion on current challenges and opportunities related to water management in the reserve’s villages.

Participants worked in thematic groups structured around three core pillars: governance, monitoring and evaluation, and communication. Through open dialogue and collective brainstorming, attendees shared experiences, identified gaps, and proposed practical solutions to improve the sustainable management of water resources in the area.

The day concluded with the development of a clear roadmap, which will guide future actions of the Association in collaboration with local authorities and residents. Implementation will take place under the supervision of a specialized water committee, whose members will be selected based on competence and full transparency.

This participatory approach reflects APJM’s commitment to inclusive governance and sustainable development, ensuring that water resources in the Jabal Moussa Biosphere Reserve are managed in a way that benefits both people and nature.
