



Training Local Workers on Water Springs and Channels Restoration

As part of its commitment to landscape restoration and community development, the Association for the Protection of Jabal Moussa organized a specialized training for local workers on the **restoration of water springs and channels** within the Jabal Moussa Biosphere Reserve.

The training is implemented under the **RES-MAB** and **ResiLAND** projects, aiming to strengthen local capacities while supporting **job improvement and job creation** in the region. Participants were trained on practical techniques for rehabilitating traditional water systems, improving water flow, preventing leakage, and ensuring long-term functionality of springs and channels that support both ecosystems and local livelihoods.

The program combined **field-based learning and technical guidance**, allowing workers to apply restoration methods directly on site. Beyond environmental benefits, the training equips participants with valuable skills that enhance employability and open opportunities for sustainable income generation linked to conservation work.

By investing in local workers, Jabal Moussa Biosphere Reserve continues to link **nature restoration with socio-economic development**, ensuring that protecting water resources also supports resilient communities and long-term employment.
